This was recorded in July 2019. Swimming lessons when they were Y5 pupils in July 2018-2019

The figures for Academic 2018-2019 (Summer Term) only show the KS2 National Curriculum as a whole (without the breakdown of each criteria like above) as we were running with the old School Swimming Programme then, so for these:

- **6 out of the 29 children achieved their KS2 award - 20.69%**
- **23 out of the 29 achieved their 25m badge – 79%**
